1. Your conversion experience and your Christian growth since then.
2. The nature of your Christian ministry activities or responsibilities up to this point in your life. Include evangelism, preaching, teaching, and leadership opportunities in which you have participated.
3. Identify the most fruitful and satisfying parts, the most difficult parts, and the greatest personal challenges you have faced in the ministry.
4. Your call to vocational ministry.
5. Your vision for ministry after you receive seminary training.
6. Why do you believe that God is leading you pursue seminary training? Why did you choose IGSL as a possible place for that training?

FOR RE-APPLICANTS:

If you have applied within the past year, you need only to provide a statement which updates your previous Spiritual Life Essay. If you are applying after you have withdrawn from (or have previously been denied admission to) an earlier application to the International Graduate School of Leadership, include in your statement the reason for your original withdrawal (or your non-acceptance) and an explanation of the changes in your circumstances that led you to re-apply.
